



## EBET RECEIVES TICKET-IN TICKET-OUT APPROVAL IN NSW

eBet Limited (EBT:ASX) announced today that it had received regulatory approval to supply Ticket-In Ticket-Out (TITO) systems technology in New South Wales with its TIKIT™ product.

TITO technology is widely used in the US Casino Industry and, following recent trials, TITO has received widespread support from Clubs and Hotels for its introduction in New South Wales.

eBet has incorporated TITO functionality into its proprietary IGMI Board, a product that has contracted sales of over 5,400 units to more than 40 Clubs and Hotels in NSW. As part of the company's strategic R&D investment, eBet adopted a 'plug-and-play' design philosophy for the IGMI Board, to enable a suite of sophisticated products to be rolled out to customers seamlessly as regulatory approvals are received.

Consistent with eBet's move to increase our recurring revenues, the IGMI allows for the introduction of new technologies to create additional recurring revenue streams for the company. TIKIT™ is the second product available with the IGMI Board, the first being eBet's BreakAway™ which was approved in April 2007.

Managing Director and CEO, Mr. Tony Toohey said "eBet is delighted to gain regulatory approval to provide TITO in New South Wales through our TIKIT™ product range. We believe demand for TITO will very be strong and we are well positioned with the IGMI Board to provide this technology to over 450 of our existing customers with over 32,000 slots connected to eBet systems in NSW".

Mr. Toohey said "we demonstrated our TITO solution alongside Octavian products at the Asian Gaming Expo in Macau last week, and received strong interest from a number from Asian-based gaming operators".
